**POSITION SUMMARY**

*This position is a dual role with responsibility for servicing and repair of pools and spas and other water features. Repairs pools, spas and/or water features and associated equipment, including, but not limited to, installing and upgrading new and existing equipment and performing leak detections and technology and automation troubleshooting. Responsible for providing regular pool service which includes cleaning and chemically balancing pools, spas or other water features in the most efficient manner, as well as maintaining all equipment in good working order. Has own established route of clients and maintains relationships to ensure consistency and company standards are met. Identifies issues or concerns to bring to manager's attention, as well as potential renovations or repairs. Maintains organization and cleanliness of truck and complies with all company and state or federal safety guidelines. Accurately captures data related to each service call and turns into the office in a timely manner.*

**Typical Tasks may include but are not limited to:**

1. Water testing and proper water treatment/chemicalization per company guidelines
2. Cleaning and maintaining gunite and vinyl pools, spas and/or water features.
3. Maintain and record accurate information on daily paperwork for service and repairs
4. Perform routine equipment checks to ensure proper operation
5. Relay problems and concerns to dispatcher and Manager immediately
6. Summerizing and Winterizing any and all pools, spas and/or water features
7. Troubleshoot and repair equipment (pumps, filters, chlorinators, salt generators, ozonators, automation systems, pool and spa lights, etc)
8. Leak Detection (pressure test lines and scuba dive, when needed.)
